

Minutes of the Greening Geneva Initiative Meeting between The Natural Resources Committee and the City of Geneva

June 6, 2014

NRC members met with representatives of the City of Geneva to discuss possible tree locations, within the downtown business district, where new trees could be planted. The site visit began at the post office and covered an area bounded by Hamilton Street to the north, South Street to the south, First Street to the east, and 6^{th} Street to the west.
