

BRUSH PICKUP PROGRAM

April 1 to November 30, 2010

The program provides two (2) City-wide pickups each month beginning in April through November. This program is intended for the disposal of only limbs/branches that are removed by the property owner for normal maintenance and upkeep, not for lot clearing. The City will not collect material produced by a private contractor.

COLLECTION SCHEDULE

EAST SIDE OF THE RIVER (1st & 3rd Week)

April 5 and April 19
May 3 and May 17
June 7 and June 21
July 5 and July 19
August 2 and August 16
September 6 and September 20
October 4 and October 18
November 1 and November 15

WESTSIDE OF THE RIVER (2nd & 4th Week)

April 12 and April 26
May 10 and May 24
June 14 and June 28
July 12 and July 26
August 9 and August 23
September 13 and September 27
October 11 and October 25
November 8 and November 22

Brush/Limbs must be placed on the parkway by 7:00 A.M. on the Monday of your scheduled collection week. Crews will not return until the next scheduled collection week.

How to Prepare Brush/Limbs

- ❑ All limbs must be stacked with the cut ends in one direction and facing the curb or edge of pavement- NOT in the street.
- ❑ Limbs/branches cannot exceed 12" in diameter and 12' feet in length. Stumps cannot exceed 12" in diameter.
- ❑ Do not tie bundles of limbs/branches with rope or wire.
- ❑ No foreign materials: construction debris, fence posts, lumber, fencing, wire will be collected
- ❑ Grass clippings, annual/perennial flowers, garden waste, small limbs and twigs will not be collected. These materials must be placed in a stickered yard waste paper bags and collected on normal refuse pickup days.

Severe Storms could delay the timeliness of the pickup due an extremely large volume of material to be collected. Every attempt will be made to deploy additional staff and equipment if such delays do develop.

Woodchips are available for pickup at the Public Works Department located at 1800 South Street.
