

January – City’s Winter Parking Regulations In Effect; Utility Bill Reading Notice

With winter weather arriving, here is some important information about parking and your January utility bill.

When snow begins to fall, Public Works clears main arterial roads first. Parking on these designated Snow Routes is prohibited when the snowfall exceeds 2 inches or more.

Once the main arterial routes are plowed, crews will then target residential neighborhoods. Parking is not permitted on these secondary roadways when there is a snowfall of 3 inches or more.

People can resume parking their car on the street after the roads have been plowed to the curb.

Regarding January utility bills, some customers might receive estimated meter readings this month given the inclement winter weather. We appreciate your understanding.
