The Commission Assistance and Mentoring Program (CAMP) is the signature training offered by National Alliance of Preservation Commissions (NAPC). CAMP® is led by qualified, nationally--recognized preservation professionals in support of local preservation commissions and the NAPC mission to *“build strong local preservation programs through education, advocacy, and training.”*

Who Attends CAMP?

CAMP is designed to provide continuing education (AIA / AICP credit) and support to local historic preservation commissions, their staff and partners--including neighborhood organizations, local and statewide non-profits, and community leaders—as well as public officials. Sessions are customized to provide maximum benefit to local and regional communities.


