
Geneva is a city of 21,495 people (2010 census) but in the 5 mile ring from downtown Geneva over 116,757 people live in 39,951 households with a 2010 average household income of \$106,664—58.8% of households have an income greater than \$75,000. (source: Esri)

The railroad arrived in 1853, bringing freight and passenger service to Chicago. Since 1840, food manufacturing has remained a major industry. Over 1,000 businesses call Geneva home and enjoy our lower cost municipal electric utility. Our largest employers are Delnor Hospital, Kane County, Peacock Engineering, Burgess Norton, Johnson Controls, Houghton Mifflin, Power Packaging, FONA, Millard Refrigeration, On-Cor Frozen Foods, The Little Traveler, Gordon Flesch, Industrial Hard Chrome, and Continental Envelope.

Geneva's character is found in its historic architecture, adaptive re-use of historic buildings, graceful trees, and attention to landscaping. Open space and recreation abound with 700 acres of park land, the 580 acre Prairie Green Preserve, 556 acres of Kane County forest preserves, two golf courses in Geneva plus another 12 (public & private) courses in the vicinity.

UTILITIES

Water and Sanitary Service Provided by City of Geneva

The City constructed a \$30 MIL reverse osmosis membrane filtration plant in 2008 (sized for expansion) which reduced water hardness levels to 6 grains. In 2009 and 2010, the Kane County Water Association awarded "Best tasting tap water in Kane County" to Geneva.

In 2004 the City completed a \$16.5 MIL Wastewater Treatment Plant improvement. The plant treats 4 to 5 mil gallons of wastewater per day (2.2 bil gallons treated in 2012). The City maintains compliance of the NPDES permit at an average of 98% efficiency. For information: (630) 232-1551.
