Q: How did they estimate the attendance?

A: Unknown. The applicant will be present Monday evening and available to answer questions directly related to information provided in the application.

Q: Will the City be able to handle the event if the estimate is low?

A: The event is not being staffed based upon the estimates given. The City is prepared with the personnel working the event should a significant amount of people attend above what has been estimated by the applicant.

Q: Does the application specify when the street will re-open to traffic?

A: Yes, please see page 136 of the agenda packet. It is estimated that the street will re-open on or before noon on the day of the event.
