3. Items of Business

f. Consider Draft Resolution Listing Exempt Development/Projects for the Revised Kane County Stormwater Ordinance.

Q: Do we know the nature of the County's changes to their stormwater standards?

A: The County has been reviewing and preparing updated language for the Kane County Stormwater Ordinance. The Mayor serves on the planning committee. There is also a Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) composed of 12 appointed by the committee. Although Geneva does not have a representative on the TAC, City staff has attended some meetings and have been contacted for input for several matters, such as detention thresholds, detention design parameters, exempt projects, certified review requirements, and fee-in-lieu opportunities. Essentially the update is to fix any problems and address any changes required by FEMA or the Illinois Department of Natural Resources. There are also several issues related to the unincorporated areas of the county that are being cleaned up. The last report received is that the planning committee is cleaning up a few items and looking towards a mid-June date for approval.
