



## NOTIFICATION TO RESIDENTS

**Re: 2026 Tree Trimming Near Electric Lines**

Dear Resident:

Tree trimming is one of the most important maintenance practices of the City of Geneva's electric utility. The proper and systematic pruning will help ensure public safety, reliable service and fewer outages.

Within the next few weeks (weather permitting), Asplundh Tree Service, a qualified line-clearance tree trimming company under contract with the City, will be pruning trees that are over, under or near the (pole to pole & pole to house) electric lines in your area. The City will be in close contact with the crews, ensuring the work is performed properly. This maintenance trimming will help prevent any safety issues and damage to the electric lines.

The pruning operation will include the removal of broken, dead, diseased, and other limbs that pose a potential to make contact with electric lines during the next three to four years.
