Dear Resident:

The City's 2021 street and water main improvement program is being completed by Builders Paving based out of Hillside.

Sidewalk removals began May 12 on the City's west side and will continue this week. Concrete replacement will start Tuesday, May 18 and should be completed by Friday, May 21, weather permitting. The City asks residents to not drive on the new concrete for at least five days.

Residents should remember to remove plantings from behind the curb next to sidewalks that are marked with white paint or that have been saw cut already.

**Some residents will have work done within their driveways. The contractor will knock on people's doors so they can remove their car from the garage before construction commences in their driveway. The City requests people park on the street in front of their house at a location not marked with white paint.**

For those homes where driveways are not being impacted, residents should not park on the street during work hours (7 a.m. to 3 p.m.) People can park in their driveway or on a cross street, whichever is more convenient.
