Our police station is facing significant infrastructure challenges and **does not meet current policing standards**. It experiences frequent flooding with both roof and sewer back-ups that regularly impact operations, ambulances do not fit inside if there is a medical emergency, and the open parking creates the potential for unsafe interactions. Additionally, there is not enough space for personnel and equipment.

On **March 17th**, we have the opportunity to consider building our officers a modern, efficient, flexible and secure police station at a cost not-to-exceed \$59.4 million - providing the high-level police services the community has come to expect and what is required under Illinois law.
