Sanitary Sewer River Crossing & New Screening Building

PROJECT # L17-6225

The City of Geneva is constructing wastewater system improvements, including the installation of a new screening building with two mechanical screen assemblies, approximately 1,128 LF of 20-inch diameter sanitary sewer, 467 LF of 30-inch diameter sanitary sewer, 346 LF of 36-inch diameter sanitary sewer, 10 manholes, 2 junction boxes, and appurtenances. This work is covered by Illinois EPA Permit Number 2024-AB 70163. Funding for this project is being provided by a low interest loan from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Water Pollution Control Loan Program (WPCLP). The WPCLP is funded by both state and federal sources. The \$12,949,750.00 loan has an interest rate of 2.16% and will be repaid over 30 years. The purpose of this project is to improve system infrastructure to continue to provide area residents and businesses in the city with adequate treatment of wastewater flows and maintain compliance with current sewer regulations.
