RE: LRS update response to COVID-19 pandemic

Dear Rich,

The following is an immediate change in our service or manner of collection.

- **Suspension of the collection of bulk items, white goods & e-waste**
  - No collection of loose material, bulk items (mattresses, furniture, etc.), appliances, electronic waste or other large items at the curb due to the safety of our drivers.

It is just becoming clear how long the coronavirus can survive outside the human body. We have learned that the virus can last on cardboard for up to 24 hours, and on metal, glass and plastic for up to nine days. In low temperatures, the virus can last on some surfaces for up to 28 days.

Please note that this immediate action will not only help protect our drivers, but will also help reduce community spread.

We are grateful for our partnership with your community and your understanding and patience during this unprecedented time. We remain committed to providing you updates and continued waste collection services.
