## **ILCC Temporarily Allows Delinquency List Payment Plans and Distributor Alcoholic Liquor Returns**

*Guidance on the payment and return of alcoholic liquor during the COVID-19 crisis*

CHICAGO— Tier 3 COVID-19 mitigation efforts went into effect November 20, 2020 in all regions of the state of Illinois. The Illinois Liquor Control Commission has taken swift action to address alcohol-related transaction issues arising from the additional mitigations in Phase 4 of the Restore Illinois plan.

### **Delinquency List**

Licensed distributors and licensed retailers may negotiate payment plans to pay an existing debt on a sale or sales of wine and spirits occurring between October 1, 2020 and November 15, 2020. Payment plans are only permitted under guidelines outlined in the following [bulletin](#).

### **Retailer to Distributor Alcoholic Liquor Returns**

Current mitigations include a prohibition on the indoor consumption of food and beverages at restaurants and bars. As a temporary measure, the ILCC is authorizing returns of beer, wine, and spirits under certain conditions outlined in the following [bulletin](#).

"These temporary measures will provide necessary regulatory and financial relief to all licensees most impacted due to the surge of COVID-19 rates and additional mitigations to stop the spread of the virus." said Chima Enyia, Executive Director, ILCC.
